The Friends of the Mines of Spain recently received a grant from the Mystique Casino/Dubuque Racing Association. The grant was for the amount of \$4840.07. The funds enabled the Friends of the Mines of Spainto purchase new equipment for the E. B. Lyons Interpretive Center at the Mines of Spain Recreation Area. The equipment purchased includes microscopes, television monitor, flex-cam video lab, dissecting equipment, and an amplifier and speakers. The dissecting and compound microscopes, flex-cam, and monitor will be used in-doors for lab programs looking at specimens found out in the park. The flex-cam and monitor will also enable attendees to see what is under a microscope in an enlarged format. The wonder-scopes will be used for programs out in the park enabling attendees on a field trip to look at specimens immediately out in the field.

The E. B. Lyons Interpretive Center will have a 7400 square feet addition constructed during the next several months. One feature to the addition will be a natural resources lab. The microscopes, monitor and flex-cam are equipment that will be essential in providing programs to schools, youth groups, and the public in addition to schools utilizing the room as an off-campus class room. The amplifier and speakers will be utilized in creating a space where visitors can sit inside the center to watch birds at the feeders, while listening to them with the aid of a microphone.

The equipment will allow park staff and volunteers to provide programs that will be at a hire level of learning than in the past. With the aide of the new equipment visitors will be able to experience nature up close.
