PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

**MONITORING VIOLATION OF THE WATER TESTING SCHEDULE**

Our water system violated a drinking water standard (s) over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

We, the Mines of Spain, Public Water Supply (include a description of the areas served if it is not evident from the supply name) are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During October we did not monitor or test a sample for bacteria and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water at that time.

**What should I do?**

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

**What Happened? What is being done?** A bacteria sample has been taken in November.
